Israel & the Latest Developments in the UN

Netanya AACI is delighted to welcome back **Alan Baker**, former Ambassador of the State of Israel to Canada, as our guest speaker in October. Ambassador Baker will update us on the implications of the latest developments in the United Nations concerning Israel. Ambassador Baker is a foremost expert on many aspects of international law who made Aliya from the UK some 47 years ago. Beginning with the IDF as legal adviser, he subsequently worked in its International Law division and then moved on to the Foreign Service. He was seconded by Israel to the UN as senior legal adviser. He was legal adviser and deputy director-general of Israel's Ministry of Foreign Affairs until being appointed Ambassador to Canada in 2004. After returning from Canada, Ambassador Baker left government service for private practice. In the past few years he has served as Director of the Institute for Contemporary Affairs at the Jerusalem Center for Public Affairs representing Israel in international conferences and negotiations, including the establishment of the International Criminal Court, and at the International Court of Justice on the matter of the security barrier. He was a member of the Government's Levy Commission, to examine the status of building in Judea and Samaria.
