Our team of play readers **Anthony Felix, Mervyn Leviton, Yael Rahum and Zvi Swerdlove** with the help of **David Feiler** will present a dramatized reading of the play *Can Two Walk Together?* written by the renowned Israeli author A B Yehoshua.

In 1934, a series of secret meetings was held in London between two bitter adversaries in the Zionist movement: from the Left, David Ben-Gurion, and from the Right, Ze'ev Jabotinsky, the revered Revisionist movement leader. The aim of the meetings was reconciliation between the two rival movements, preventing the secession of Jabotinsky's movement from the Zionist Organization, and the creation of a new organization. Against the backdrop of these meetings, A.B. Yehoshua has built a compelling political and personal drama focusing on one of the decisive historic crossroads in the history of Zionism.

After a short break, A B Yehoshua will lead a discussion in English comparing the political tensions that prevail today with those that are portrayed in the play as existing before the establishment of the State of Israel.
