He is one of the world's pre-eminent experts on universal jurisdiction and maritime piracy, as well as international law and the Israel-Arab conflict. He is recognized as an authority on the legitimacy of Jewish settlements in Judea and Samaria and their legal standing in international law.

Professor Kontorovich has advised top officials and government departments in both the US and Israel. He is widely cited and published in the media, such as the New York Times, Wall Street Journal, ANPR, AP, Reuters, Haaretz and more.
