Harvey Bordowitz Music Lecture Series 2018 THE MAGICAL MUSICAL TOUR IS BACK!

Following the popular success of five lecture series at Netanya AACI, conductor and music lecturer Harvey Bordowitz invites you to join him for the sixth season, to learn while enjoying the thrill of great music. For more than three decades, Harvey Bordowitz has been esteemed as one of this country's most innovative and creative conductors and music directors, and has guest-conducted orchestras throughout the world. For 40 plus years he has lectured in both Hebrew and English on a vast range of musical topics, with humor, erudition and a deep love of music.



7.30pm Sunday 7 January THE PIED PIPER OF MUSIC – LEONARD BERNSTEIN

Tonight we celebrate the hundredth anniversary of the birth of Leonard Bernstein – brilliant conductor, composer, pianist, and educator – who led a generation of young people to understand and love classical music; a champion of the world-wide Mahler revival, and a deeply committed Jew and lover of Israel - one of music's towering figures of the 20th century.

7.30pm Sunday 21 January WUNDERKINDER – MUSIC'S GREAT CHILD-PRODIGIES

At an age when other children were playing street-games, young Wolfgang Mozart was performing for royalty. Mendelssohn was already a prolific composer as a child. Tonight, we will meet them, as well as Schubert, Chopin, Albeniz, Saint-Saëns and Britten and more – child prodigies who grew to be great composers.

7.30pm Sunday 4 February ITALIA

From the ancient Roman Empire to modern times, Italy has woven its magic spell over the world – in history, architecture, art, and, of course, music, both sacred and secular. We will explore Italy's immortal musical heritage, from Monteverdi to Verdi, stopping by way of Corelli, Vivaldi, Boccherini, Leoncavallo (and, yes, Salieri, too) and more. Neapolitan song, too, will have its place in the sun.

7.30pm Sunday 18 February ONE FOR ALL AND ALL FOR ONE – THE CONCERTO

What could be more thrilling in music than a virtuoso's death-defying acrobatic feats, performed on stage to the accompaniment of the orchestra? In this lecture, we will be learning about the concerto, its origin, history, and development into one of the most beloved of all musical genres, and we will hear samples of the greatest masterworks, performed by supreme soloists. We'll also learn all about the *concerto grosso*. Fireworks are in store!

7.30pm Sunday 4 March A DEVIL OF A LECTURE!

Satan, Lucifer, Mephisto, Beelzebub – the Devil has many names, but one trait – he is pure evil. The sworn enemy of God, he is cunning, seductive and devious, and labors tirelessly to lead humanity to perdition. We'll be making the Devil's acquaintance through music by Mozart, Berlioz, Weber, Paganini, Tartini, Saint-Saëns, Boito and many more. We'll have a devil of a time!
