Get up close to nature by signing up for an exciting visit to the brand new **Steinhardt Museum of Natural History (Tel Aviv)** which opened the doors of its stunningly designed modern building this summer to receive its first visitors. Having brought together collections gathered over decades, the Steinhardt Museum now offers millions of items in displays that document the fauna and flora of the Eastern Mediterranean in the past century, alongside the history and development of the human species. The museum also offers a wide range of special exhibits based on its scientific collection that includes stuffed animals and skeletons that tell the story of nature or represent phenomena unique to those animals.



In addition to just appealing to the public's enjoyment, the Steinhardt Museum is also used by hundreds of scientists and professionals from Israel and overseas for educational and research purposes that include the management and conservation of ecosystems and the sustainable utilization of natural resources. More than 100 research students now use the collection annually for their MSc and PhD projects.

The museum, built on four floors, incorporates all modern amenities, including diverse multimedia content and facilities for the disabled. Our guided tour will take us around the exhibition with free time for individual browsing.
