Neri Zilber is a journalist and analyst on Middle East politics and culture, a research associate at the Rubin Center for International Research, IDC Herzliya and an adjunct fellow of the Washington Institute for Near East Policy. In July 2017 he wrote an op-ed in The New York Times entitled, *Israel's Secret Arab Allies*, in which he concluded:

"... Israel is now involved in the Arab world's military campaigns — against both Iran and its proxies, as well as against the Islamic State. It remains to be seen whether this is merely a temporary marriage of convenience against common foes or the start of an enduring strategic realignment."

Raised and educated in Israel, Singapore, Spain and the United States, Neri holds a bachelor's degree from the School of Foreign Service, Georgetown University and a master's degree from the Department of War Studies, King's College London.

Previously held appointments include fellow of the Institute of Current World Affairs based in Israel and researcher and analyst at the US Library of Congress and the World Jewish Congress. As a journalist and analyst on Middle East politics and culture, he is quoted regularly in the international press, and has appeared on CNN, BBC, NPR, and CBS.
