SPRING FLOWERS IN THE JUDEAN FOOTHIILLS

Monday 5 March

Our guided tour in English, arranged by the **Society for the Protection of Nature in Israel**, begins in the lovely hills of **Shfelat Yehuda** walking through the spring flowers: Irises, cyclamen, mountain lupines and many more in their multitude of colours accompanied by stories from the Bible.

Tel Azaka Lookout: After a short climb up steps to a beautiful view overlooking the Valley of Elah, we will hear the story of the battle of David and Goliath.

Tel Shochar: An easy walk amongst the blue mountain lupines.

Tel Lachish: A gentle stroll up to the lookout where we will become acquainted with the second most important town in the Kingdom of Judea. We will hear the story of the battle against the Assyrians, immortalised in reliefs..... all this accompanied by spring flowers.

Nativ HaLamed-Heh Monument: Named after the 35 Haganah soldiers killed in a convoy to resupply the Gush Etzion kibbutzim during the 1947-48 clashes prior to the War of Independence.

The Society for the Protection of Nature have specified that this tiyul can only take place if we have the minimum number of participants.
